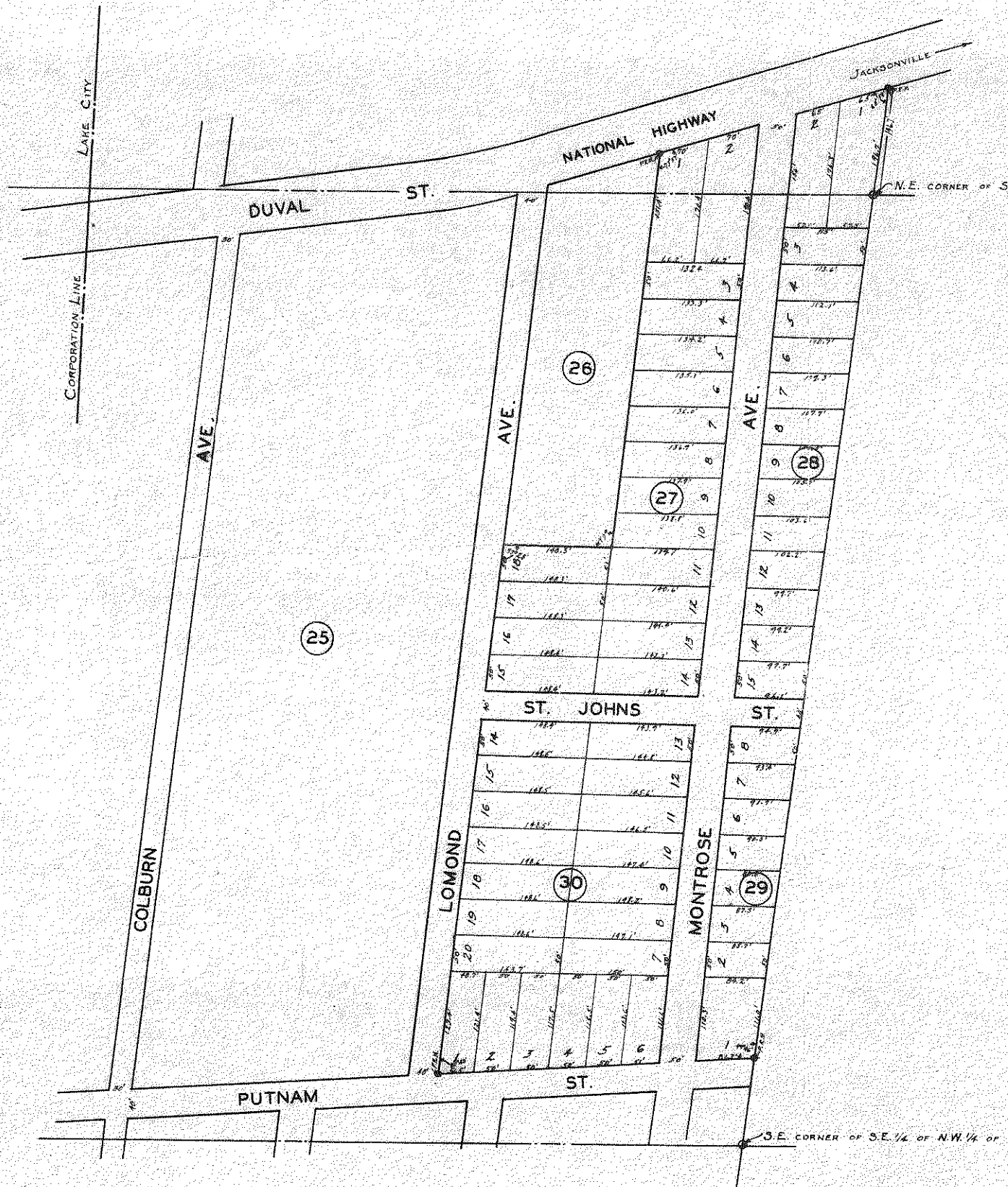


CAMPBOR KNOL

~ DESCRIPTION ~

Begin at the N.E. corner of the S.E. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Section 33-Township 3 South, Range 17 East, Columbia County Florida, and run N 7° E. 146.7 ft. to the National Highway; thence S 71° W. along south side of said highway 386 ft.; thence S. 5° 30' W. 551.4 ft.; thence S. 88° 45' E. 140.5 ft. to Leeward Avenue; thence along the east line of said street 715.4 ft. to Putnam Street; thence N. 86° 30' E. along north line of Putnam Street 433.0 ft.; thence N 7° E. 120.1 ft. along quarter section line to point of beginning. Tract contains 11.6 acres.
